The City of Brownsboro Farm Pool Regulations

The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all members and to assure the safe and sanitary operation of the pool. Parents are required to instruct their children to observe the rules and to obey the instructions of the lifeguards and Pool Monitor.

Any failure to comply with these rules / instructions shall be considered sufficient cause for immediate suspension of pool privileges for the offender.

All persons using any of the pool and park facilities do so at their own risk. The Parks Board and City will not be responsible for any accident or injury in connection with the use.

The Parks Board and City will not be responsible for any loss or damage to personal items.

The Pool may be closed or the operating hours revised, for maintenance, weather, or any other reasons deemed sufficient.

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH) RULES

Health and Safety: The following requirements are from the Louisville and Jefferson County Board of Health Regulations, Chapter 900, Swimming Pools and Bathing Beaches.

900.1702 Facilities shall enforce the following rules. These rules shall be posted on placards at the entrance to the pool area. Lettering on this placard shall be at least 1/2 inches in height.

a) Admission to the facility shall be refused to all persons having any contagious disease, or those with conditions that appear contagious. Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions which have not healed, corn plasters, bunion pads, adhesive tape, rubber bandages of any kind are not permitted. A person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted in the facility area.

b) No glass or gum within the pool area.

NO SMOKING INSIDE THE FENCED AND PATIO AREA

c) No food, drink or tobacco allowed outside designated areas.

CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF & YOUR CHILDREN

d) No running or rough play allowed.

e) No street shoes allowed on deck.

f) All apparel worn into the facility shall be clean.

g) All persons must shower before entering the pool.

h) No diving in shallow water.

i) No animals allowed in the area.

In addition to those rules listed the Parks Board adds the following:

- a) **NO SMOKING INSIDE THE FENCE AND PATIO AREA**
- b) All persons entering the pool must be appropriately dressed for swimming. No one dressed in shorts, slacks or other street apparel will be permitted in the pool.
- c) Absolutely, No disposable diapers will be permitted in either pool. Disposable swim diapers are allowed. Please be considerate to other swimmers.
- d) All water guns, water pistols, soakers, and non-water balls (i.e. tennis and footballs...) etc. are prohibited from the pool area
- e) There will be no running, pushing, wrestling, dunking or excessive roughness in or about the pool area or bathhouse.
- f) No more than one person will be allowed on the diving board at a time. Divers are permitted to dive from the front end of the board only when the diving area is clear of swimmers. **Divers are not to jump to the pools' sides. Divers must exit from the sides of the pool. Diving with or onto flotation devices is not permitted.**
- g) Large flotation devices are prohibited from the shallow end, however may be used in the deep end. The use of floats are at the guard's discretion.

Baby Pool:

The Baby Pool is operated as a convenience to those with children too small to safely enjoy the main pool. However, it is not possible for the lifeguard to properly supervise the baby pool on a continuous basis. For this reason, the baby pool is posted as having "No Lifeguard on Duty". In order to operate the baby pool safely, the following rules apply.

- a) No one over the age of four (4) shall use the baby pool.
- b) Children using the baby pool require supervision by a responsible person inside the enclosed area. The lifeguard will instruct unsupervised children to leave the baby pool and the enclosed area.

Member Obligations:

Membership bracelets must be worn while at the pool. A replacement bracelet may be purchased for \$5.00 from individuals listed on the front of the pool packet.

- No child under the age of 11 shall be left without parental or approved supervision.
- Responsible, approved supervision **MUST** check in with the lifeguard on duty & identify which children they have responsibility.
- Lifeguards may implement a swim test at their discretion.
- Sign the Pool Register when entering pool area and indicate number of Members & Guests.
- Assist in Pool Membership Drive.
- Observe Pool Hours and Restrictions.
- No offensive or abusive language will be permitted.
- Food or Drink containers, of any kind, are not permitted in the pool itself.
- No loud or offensive music will be allowed.
- All bicycles, roller blades and skateboards will be left outside the fenced area.
- Property damage will be charged to the responsible member.
- Only Professional Pool Management (PPM) lifeguards can provide swim lessons at the pool.

NOTE: Lifeguards have the right and authority to ask adult members to refrain from further consumption and/or to remove themselves from the premises.

Guest Policy

- Guest bracelet must be worn while at pool.
- Maximum number of guests is (6) unrelated per member family.
- Non-Member residents of Brownsboro Farm may not be guests.
- No unattended guests. Guests must leave when member leaves.
- No individual or group may be invited as a guest by any member for swimming privileges more than **twice a week, nor two consecutive days**. A week is from Sunday – Saturday. Members under 16 years of age are limited to two guests at any time unless under parental supervision. All guests must sign in the Guest Register and introduce themselves to the guard on duty.
- Private parties are not appropriate during normal pool hours. Any exceptions must have prior approval from the Pool Manager.
- Conduct of guests is the responsibility of the host, who shall be liable for any violations and / or damages caused by their guests.

Summer Babysitters

- A babysitter hired to care for a pool member's child or children over the summer will need to have a purchased guest bracelet. Please give the Pool Monitor the name of your sitter.

Houseguests

- While the houseguest is staying in the neighborhood with a pool member they may visit the pool as often as they like. Please give the Pool Monitor the name of your houseguest and the dates they are visiting with you. You may pick up a guest bracelet from any individual listed on the front of the packet.

Lifeguard Breaks:

- From 10 minutes before the hour until the hour, the lifeguard is not on duty and NO ONE will be permitted in the pool. (Health Department rule)
- Adults may swim during break only on days when two lifeguards are on duty and have a staggered break schedule.

Family Swim Times:

- Family Swim time shall be observed Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 5:00 p.m. until 5:50 p.m. Family swim is designated for families. (Upon request – See guard)
- Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent during family swim.
- A lap lane will be available from 6-7:30 pm Monday-Friday. (Upon request - See guard)
- If the lap lane is in use the deep end will be open but the diving board will be closed.

Penalties For Violations:

- Professional Pool Management lifeguards will advise a minor aged patron if they are doing something wrong and will advise to stop. If the lifeguard needs to advise the minor to stop a 2nd time the minor will sit out of the pool 15 minutes. If the lifeguard needs to advise a 3rd time then the minor will be told to leave the pool and cannot return until brings parents to speak with lifeguard or management.
- Members who trespass on pool property after hours will be suspended for the duration of the pool season. They may be prosecuted for trespassing.
- Members responsible for any acts of vandalism will be expected to pay for the repairs. Any acts of vandalism or injury to others will also lead to a suspension for a period determined by the Pool Manager.
