

**City of Brownsboro Farm  
Regular Commission Meeting  
Tuesday, August 10th, 2010**

A regular meeting of the Brownsboro Farm City Commission was held on Tuesday, August 10th, 2010 at the Brownsboro Farm Community Center. Mayor Mosher called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m. Present were Commissioners Marc Salmon, David Watson, Tim Quinn, Mayor Josh Mosher and City Clerk Dennis Branson. Residents John Shea, Charlie Spencer, and Bob Bale were also present.

The meeting was called to order at 7:33.

The agenda was amended to take off Commissioners Salmon and White.

The Minutes from July were approved.

The Financials from July 2010 were approved. City Treasurer Branson reported that insurance revenues were \$1,500 over budget during the first quarter of the fiscal year .

**David Watson**

Commissioner Watson reported that he talked to AT&T regarding wireless prices. They are running a special right now. Basic business services regularly costs \$79.95 per month but we can get it for \$27.49 per month with no upfront costs. We can sign a one year or two year contract and there is a termination cost of \$12.00 per month for early termination.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to allocate funds from line 54314 –cc-Cable – in the amount of \$27.49 plus taxes monthly to get wireless service for the community center. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Salmon and passed unanimously.

**Parks Board**

Commissioner Watson made a motion to allocate funds from line 54200 – Community Center Social – in the amount of \$250.00 for the city-wide Halloween party. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Salmon and passed unanimously.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to allocate funds from line 54200 – Community Center Social – in the amount of \$700.00 for the city-wide fall festival. The motion was seconded by Mayor Mosher and passed unanimously.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to allocate funds from line 55156 – Pool Social – in the amount of 150.00 for the August kid's crafternoon. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Quinn and passed unanimously.

Commissioner Watson reported that he is working on getting the boiler certified.

**Tim Quinn**

Commissioner Quinn reported that we need to proceed with our options regarding the Gazette now that Janice Moss-Brown has published her last issue. After lengthy discussion it was agreed that we do not have enough material to publish the Gazette monthly, and that it would be more cost effective to

distribute the Gazette electronically. It was agreed that we need to redefine the job of Gazette editor. Since communications in under Commissioner Quinn, he will be the liaison and bring people to be interviewed by the commission. Commissioner Salmon will forward our job application to Commissioner Quinn.

Commissioner Salmon suggested that the Commission review the Gazette before it is published. There was also a discussion of increasing the advertising revenue from the Gazette.

A resident asked if we have available funds for a block party. The commission replied that it does not have a budget for this item.

Commissioner Quinn is still working on getting costs for repaving the streets, both in entirety and in sections.

**Mayor Mosher**

Mayor Mosher asked City Clerk Branson to contact Tara Work regarding billing the non-resident members of the swim team.

The meeting was motioned and adjourned at 8:25 p.m.
