

**City of Brownsboro Farm  
Regular Commission Meeting

Mayor Moser was going to talk to the city attorney regarding stronger collection methods.

The Parks Board had nothing to report. Mayor Mosher reported that the City Attorney is working on the discrepancies between our Ordinance and KRS rules. He is completing an in depth review of statutes, case law and attorney generals' opinions.
