Bob Ray came and gave us a proposal about the big tree trunk and the smaller trees that fell in the park. The tree trunk is \$360, and the rest of the trees is \$1,630. \$2,087 total.

Commissioner Holthouse made a motion to allocate funds from line 54175 – Parks – Tree Removal - in the amount of NTE \$2,200 to pay Bob Ray to remove the tree trunk and the fallen trees. The motion was seconded by Commissioner McGrath and passed unanimously.

The lights at the front on the City have put put up.

The people are still parking in the yard on Old Brownsboro Farm Road.

A resident complained that a neighbor has been making excessive noise. We suggest that the resident contact the police about the issue.

Commissioner Barger

Commissioner Barger brought up that some residents have been putting up decorations on city property. Commissioner Quinn suggested that we put an item in the Gazette next November saying that we appreciate everyone's decorations but mentioning that the corners are city property.

Commissioner McGrath

Commissioner McGrath mentioned that the Gazette has the wrong recycling dates for December.

Yard waste will be picked up year round with the trash and trees can be placed out with the trash as long as they are in 4ft secure bundles. A resident built a privacy fence with the finished side in. They did not get a permit from us. Code says that the
