

**City of Brownsboro Farm  
Regular Commission Meeting  
Tuesday, October 10th, 2016**

A regular meeting of the Brownsboro Farm City Commission was held on Tuesday, 10/10/2016 at the Brownsboro Farm Community Center. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. Present were Commissioners Jonathan Ratliff, Kim Franklin, and Barbara Rice, Mayor Marc Salmon, City Clerk Dennis Branson and residents Charlie Spencer, and Bruce Kinnaird.

The meeting was called to order at 7:33 p.m. by Mayor Salmon.

The Agenda was amended to add a building permit for Bruce Kinnaird.

The minutes from September were approved. Motioned by Mayor Salmon and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Ratliff.

The financials from September were approved. Motioned by Mayor Salmon and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Franklin.

**Building Permit**

Mayor Salmon made a motion for a 6 ft. privacy fence for Charlie Kennard of 3807 Burning Bush Road. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Rice, and passed unanimously.

**Parks Board**

The parks board did not have a quorum, and everything got pushed back to next month.

Mayor Salmon talked with Charlie Spencer about having Bob Ray do a treatment to try and save the roses in the front.

**Commissioner Franklin**

Commissioner Franklin has a sent a map over to QK4 regarding the next section of the road to repave for next fiscal year. Charlie Spencer asked about putting off paving any more sections for a few years. Mayor Salmon and Commissioner Franklin both said that QK4's recommendation is smart to keep doing sections each year to replace the road before it gets really bad.

**Commission Ratliff**

Commissioner Ratliff reported that the water leak was found and repaired. The cause was the wrong fittings installed originally in the Community Center. They should have used high pressure valves. We have claimed the repair on our insurance. We have a 2 ft by 3 ft section of concrete to be replaced.

**Commissioner Rice**

Commissioner Rice will check on the status of the insurance claim. She still needs to set up meeting with Chad about snow removal. Mayor Salmon said there were two damaged garbage cans at the Community Center, and asked Commissioner Rice to get Rumpke to take them away.

**Mayor Salmon**

Mayor Salmon made a motion to allocate funds from line 54200 –City – Social - in the amount not to exceed \$200 to pay Samantha Puckett for afternoon with Santa. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Ratliff and passed unanimously.
