

ORDINANCE NO. 840.2, SERIES 2011

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK, FOWLS AND ANIMALS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BROWNSBORO FARM, EXCEPTING THE KEEPING OF ANIMALS AS PETS; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by City Commission of the City of Brownsboro Farm:

Section 1. In the public interest of health, welfare and sanitary conditions it shall be unlawful for any person to keep or harbor any livestock, fowls and animals within the corporate limits of the City of Brownsboro Farm; except such animals as are excepted in Section 2 of this Ordinance. This prohibition specifically includes, but is not limited to, chicken coops and similar roosting enclosures for birds.

Section 2. Nothing contained in this ordinance shall prevent any person from owning, keeping or harboring animals as personal pets, provided they are not kept for other persons for profit; for sale to others, or in excessive numbers so as to cause a nuisance within the corporate limits of the City.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$25.00 and the costs of the action for each offense; and each day in which such violation shall be permitted to exist shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective as soon as passed and published according to law.
