

AN ORDINANCE Relating to the Control of Rubbish Within the City of Brownsboro Farm.

Be it ordained by the City of Brownsboro Farm, that:

Section One. It shall be unlawful for any person, or persons, to throw or place any dirt, rubbish, nails, tacks, spikes, wire, broken metal objects, glass, potteryware or any sharp or dangerous rubbish, stone, or metal of any kind in any street, alley or public way in the City of Brownsboro Farm, or allow to accumulate on private property in either the front or rear of the property.

Section Two. It shall be the duty of every owner, tenant, lease or occupant of any and every building and place of business within the limits of the City of Brownsboro Farm to comply with the following concerning rubbish removal:

- i. Household trash receptacles, recycling containers and yard waste may not be placed at the curb prior to 6:00 PM on the evening before the City's established pick-up and cannot be observed from the public ways of the City of Brownsboro Farm after 8:00 PM on day of the City's established weekly waste pick-up.
- ii. Normal household trash must be placed in the 95-gallon receptacle provided by the City's waste removal vendor. This includes food matter, household trash, and discarded household items that will fit into the receptacle. If, and only if, the trash receptacle has been filled to capacity the residents may set suitable and sufficient trash receptacles at the curb for pick-up.
- iii. Large loose items must be bundled, not to exceed four feet in length or 70 lbs.
- iv. It is the owner, tenant, lease or occupant's responsibility to personally contact the City's waste removal vendor for pick-up of larger items.
- v. The following items are not considered part of the City's waste removal program and must be disposed of according to EPA regulations:
  - a. Construction debris
  - b. Yard waste
  - c. Hazardous materials
  - d. Tires
  - e. Batteries
  - f. Liquids, such as oil or paint
  - g. CFC's, such as Freon
- vi. Recycling must be placed only in the 18-gallon recycling bin provided by the City's waste removal vendor. The following items will be recycled by the City's waste removal vendor:
  - a. Plastics #1 through #7
  - b. Aluminum cans

- c. Bi-metal cans
  - d. Glass bottles and jars of all colors
  - e. Newspapers
  - f. "Junk" mail
  - g. Cardboard broken down 2' x 2'
- i. Yard waste will be collected by the City's waste removal vendor within the established schedule as posted by the City. Only the following will be collected by the City's waste removal vendor: grass, weeds, leaves, pruning's and branches, not more than 3 inches in diameter or 4 feet in length and assorted shrubbery. Yard waste must be placed in suitable and sufficient (30-32 gallon) trash cans, labeled "yard waste," or placed in standard plastic or paper bags, labeled "yard waste." Loose items should be bundled, not to exceed four feet in length or 50 lbs. Removal of larger items such as tree or yard debris exceeding the above guidelines for size and weight will be the responsibility of the owner, tenant, lease or occupant.

Section Three. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty-Five (\$25.00) nor more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each offense, and each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section Four. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
