A regular meeting of the Brownsboro Farm City Commission was held on Tuesday, 2/9/2021 at the Brownsboro Farm Community Center. Commissioner McGrath made a motion to allocate funds from line 56100 – Road Fund – Lawn Service - in the amount of NTE \$3,302 to pay Scarce Lawncare to re-landscape the front entrance. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Holthouse and passed unanimously.

Commissioner McGrath made a motion to allocate funds from line 51500 – City – Lawn Service - in the amount of NTE \$450 to pay Scarce Lawncare to replace bushes on the corners. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Holthouse and passed unanimously.

Commissioner Danner

We have had two people apply to be the new editor for the Gazette. Commissioner Danner was asking when we need to start talking about our usual social functions in the spring and summer. Mayor Franklin said that we need to keep monitoring the situation and government regulations. There was a discussion regarding having the Easter Egg Hunt.
