We have a directory that is on the city web site. All information must be entered voluntarily by the actual residents and cannot be entered by city officials. This will ensure that each resident controls what information is included about their household. Please let me know if you have any questions about this or if you need any help logging in to the site.



Our new online directory is up and running!

Please follow these directions and don't skip steps...including the confirmation email which expires 2 hours after it's sent!! One person in the household can fill out for both! Don't do two entries for one home please.

- 1) Go to this link: <https://cityofbrownsborofarm.membershiptoolkit.com>
- 2) click Register/Login and then either create an account (or log in with a Membership Toolkit account if you have one with another organization - like a school).
- 3) You will be asked to verify your email and then log back in with your password and add your homeowner information which will build our directory and database.

****Please note that when you create your account and receive the email to verify, that link expires within 2 hours.****

- 4) Once you are a member and begin to fill out your info you can choose what will be shown online in the directory. (Kids names, pets, etc.)
- 5) Once you have completed your information you can then download the app if you would like for easier viewing of the directory. It's called **Membership Toolkit**.

The pool remains a mainstay in our small community. It is a great place to relax and get to know your neighbors. Our pool and park are like no other in the area thus adding value to your home. Please, consider becoming a member of your pool!

All expenses for pool operation are paid from the membership fees. In order to meet increasing expenses relating to pool management and maintenance, the Commission has determined that the membership fee will increase for 2023. Effective this summer, the fee will increase by **\$50.00**. Several additional expenses we have incurred include an increase in the pool management company contract, cost of pool supplies and chemicals and increase in pay for lifeguards. In addition, we have had an insurance increase as well as necessary maintenance and repairs that are unforeseen.

The City of Brownsboro Farm Pool Regulations

The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all members and to assure the safe and sanitary operation of the pool. Parents are required to instruct their children to observe the rules and to obey the instructions of the lifeguards and Pool Monitor.

Any failure to comply with these rules / instructions shall be considered sufficient cause for immediate suspension of pool privileges for the offender.

All persons using any of the pool and park facilities do so at their own risk. The City will not be responsible for any accident or injury in connection with the use.

The City will not be responsible for any loss or damage to personal items.

The Pool may be closed or the operating hours revised, for maintenance, weather, or any other reasons deemed sufficient.

Health and Safety: The following requirements are from the Louisville and Jefferson County Board of Health Regulations, Chapter 900, Swimming Pools and Bathing Beaches.

900.1702 Facilities shall enforce the following rules. These rules shall be posted on placards at the entrance to the pool area. Lettering on this placard shall be at least 1/2 inches in height.

- a) Admission to the facility shall be refused to all persons having any contagious disease, or those with conditions that appear contagious. Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions which have not healed, corn plasters, bunion pads, adhesive tape, rubber bandages of any kind are not permitted. A person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted in the facility area.
- b) No glass or gum within the pool area
NO SMOKING OR VAPING INSIDE THE FENCED AND PATIO AREA
- c) No food, drink, tobacco or vaping products allowed outside designated areas (including the pool edge and within the pool itself – no exceptions)
CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF & YOUR CHILDREN
- d) No running or rough play allowed.
- e) No street shoes allowed on deck.
- f) All apparel worn into the facility shall be clean.
- g) All persons must shower before entering the pool.
- h) No diving in shallow water.
- i) No animals allowed in the area.

In addition to those rules listed the City adds the following:

- *ID Bands will be on all guests at all times*
- *Guests are only allowed to visit two weekdays and one weekend day for a total of three days per week.*
- All persons entering the pool must be appropriately dressed for swimming. No one dressed in shorts, slacks or other street apparel will be permitted in the pool.

- Absolutely, NO disposable diapers will be permitted in either pool. *Disposable swim diapers are allowed.* Please be considerate to other swimmers.
- All Water Guns, Water Pistols, Soakers, etc. are Prohibited from the Pool Area
- There will be no running, pushing, wrestling, dunking or excessive roughness in or about the pool area or bathhouse.
- No more than one person will be allowed on the diving board at a time. Divers are permitted to dive from the front end of the board only when the diving area is clear of swimmers. Divers are not to jump to the pools' sides. Divers must exit from the sides of the pool. Diving with or onto flotation devices is not permitted.
- Large flotation devices may be used at the guard's discretion.

Baby Pool:

The Baby Pool is operated as a convenience to those with children too small to safely enjoy the main pool. However, it is not possible for the lifeguard to properly supervise the baby pool on a continuous basis. For this reason, the baby pool is posted as having "No Lifeguard on Duty". In order to operate the baby pool safely, the following rules apply.

- No one over the age of four (4) shall use the baby pool.
- Children using the baby pool require supervision by a responsible person inside the enclosed area. The lifeguard will instruct unsupervised children to leave the baby pool and the enclosed area.

Member Obligations:

- No child under the age of 11 shall be left without parental or approved supervision.
- Responsible, approved supervision MUST check in with the lifeguard on duty & identify for which children they have responsibility.
- Lifeguards may implement a swim test at their discretion.
- Sign the Pool Register when entering pool area and indicate number of Members & Guests.
- Observe Pool Hours and Restrictions.
- No offensive or abusive language will be permitted.
- Food or Drink containers, of any kind, are not permitted in the pool itself.
- No loud or offensive music will be allowed.
- All bicycles, roller blades and skateboards will be left outside the fenced area.
- Property damage will be charged to the responsible member.
- Only Professional Pool Mgt. (PPM) lifeguards can provide swim lessons at the pool

NOTE: Lifeguards have the right and authority to ask adult members to refrain from further consumption of alcohol and/or to remove themselves from the premises. No person under the age of 21 shall consume alcohol at the pool.

Lifeguard Breaks:

- From 10 minutes before the hour until the hour, the lifeguard is not on duty and NO ONE will be permitted in the pool. (Health Department rule)
- Adults may swim during break only on days when two lifeguards are on duty and have a staggered break schedule.

Pool Furniture:

- Tables, chairs and chaise lounges are intended for use by members and their guests only while present in the pool area, therefore pool furniture cannot be reserved for later use by placing towels or personal belongings on the tables or chairs.
- Pool furniture should only be moved temporarily and should be placed back in its proper place when leaving the pool area.

Anti-Bullying Policy:

Bullying of any kind including use of offensive language is unacceptable and will not be tolerated. We are committed to providing a safe and friendly environment for all of our members. If bullying does occur, the incident will be dealt with promptly and will be considered to be a serious violation of Pool Regulations, disciplinary action to include possible suspension or revocation to membership. Anyone who knows that bullying is happening is expected to report the incident to a life guard, pool monitor, commissioner or parks board member.

Penalties For Violations of Pool Rules and Regulations:

- The consequences for violation of the pool rules are as follows:
 - ☑ 1st infraction: Verbal Warning
 - ☑ 2nd infraction: Sent home for the day
 - ☑ 3rd infraction: Suspension 7 days
 - ☑ 4th infraction: Suspension for the rest of the pool season. *as deemed by lifeguards, Pool Monitor or member of the Commission
- Members who refuse to obey the guard's instructions will be asked to leave the premises. The Pool Monitor will be contacted for appropriate action.
- Members who trespass on pool property after hours will be suspended for the duration of the pool season. They may be prosecuted for trespassing.
- Members responsible for any acts of vandalism will be expected to pay for the repairs. Any acts of vandalism or injury to others will also lead to a suspension for a period determined by the Pool Monitor.

2023 Private Pool Party Agreement – Members only

The pool member(s) and family (hereinafter “I/we”) are responsible for the conduct of our guests and the contents of the pool area. I / we also agree to be responsible for the cleanliness of the pool and surrounding area during the hours we have rented the pool. I / we agree to pay for any damages and/or clean-up expenses incurred.

I/we agree to abide by all City of Brownsboro Farm pool regulations as outlined in the pool member’s packet.

Alcoholic beverages **are not to be served at a party for minors.** (Persons under the age of 21). If alcoholic beverages are found on the premises at a party for minors, the party will end and the pool will be closed. A refund will not be given for a party terminated for alcoholic beverages being served to minors. **No glass** containers are allowed inside the fenced area.

The **responsible adult member must be present on the pool premises for the entire duration** of the party. You must clean up all areas used including: Playground, patio & parking lot. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of the damage deposit.

There is a rental fee of \$150 for a party of up to 50 people and \$250 for parties over 50 people, as well as a \$200 damage deposit. \$50 of the rental fee will be needed to be put down at time of booking to ensure we can confirm a lifeguard. The remainder of fees shall be paid to the Pool Monitor at least one week prior to the date of the party (these fees do not include access to the Community Center).

In addition, there is a fee of \$20 per hour/per lifeguard, will be supplied by PPM.

Parties may normally be scheduled any day between closing to 12:00 am. Parties at other times require permission from the Pool Monitor.

Pool Member’s Release

The pool member signing this release, on behalf of themselves and their family members, shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Brownsboro Farm, its Commission, agents and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses (including attorney’s fees), arising from their and/or their guest’s use of the pool and adjoining facilities.
