I personally sat at the corner of Old Brownsboro Hill and Fallen Timber/Cascade Tuesday evening and witnessed 24 cars in a ten-minute period that did not stop at the stop signs. This could easily turn into a tragedy. Please pay attention, especially on nights of swim meets when we will have hundreds of visitors who are not familiar with the city.






