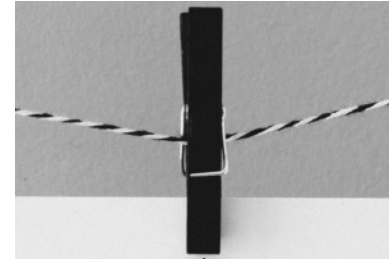

With the closing of the school year and the opening of the pool season, it is important to watch for neighbors walking or biking to the pool. We have a serious problem with cars not stopping at stop signs, especially on Old Brownsboro Hill Road. I have asked the police department to patrol intersections more closely and to issue citations if necessary. I personally sat at the corner of Old Brownsboro Hill and Fallen Timber/Cascade Tuesday evening and witnessed 24 cars in a ten-minute period that did not stop at the stop signs. This could easily turn into a tragedy. Please pay attention, especially on nights of swim meets when we will have hundreds of visitors who are not familiar with the city.

4) Once you are a member and begin to fill out your info you can choose what will be shown online in the directory. (Kids names, pets, etc.)

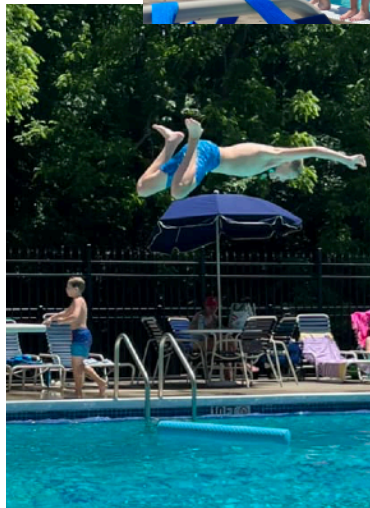
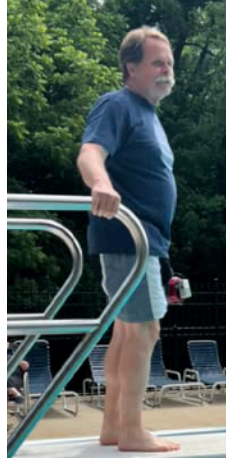
5) Once you have completed your information you can then download the app if you would like for easier viewing of the directory. It's called **Membership Toolkit**.

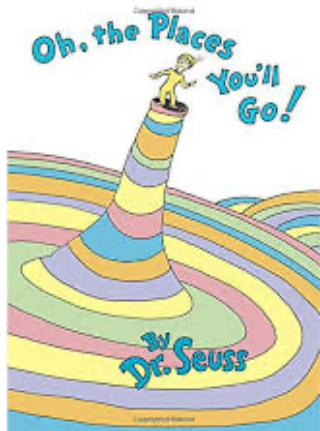

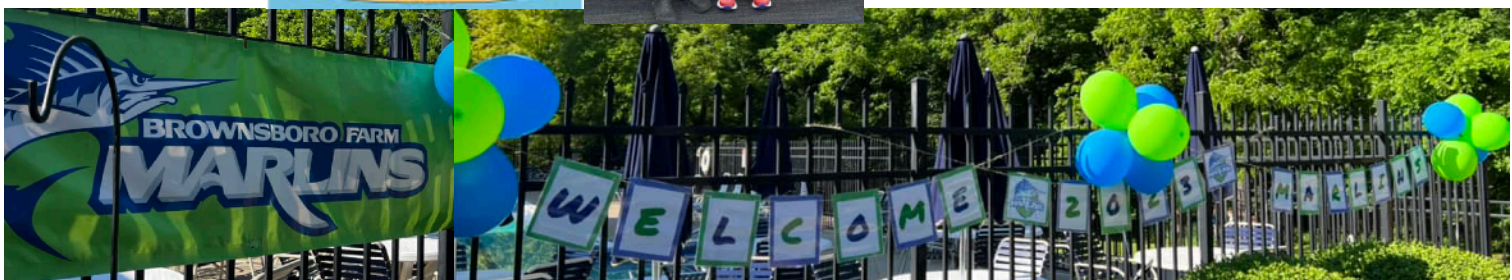

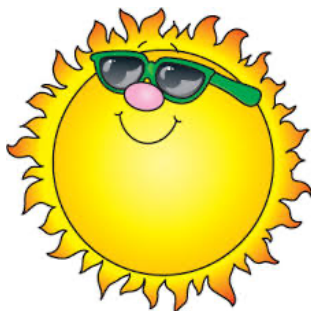
Things to bring to the meet:

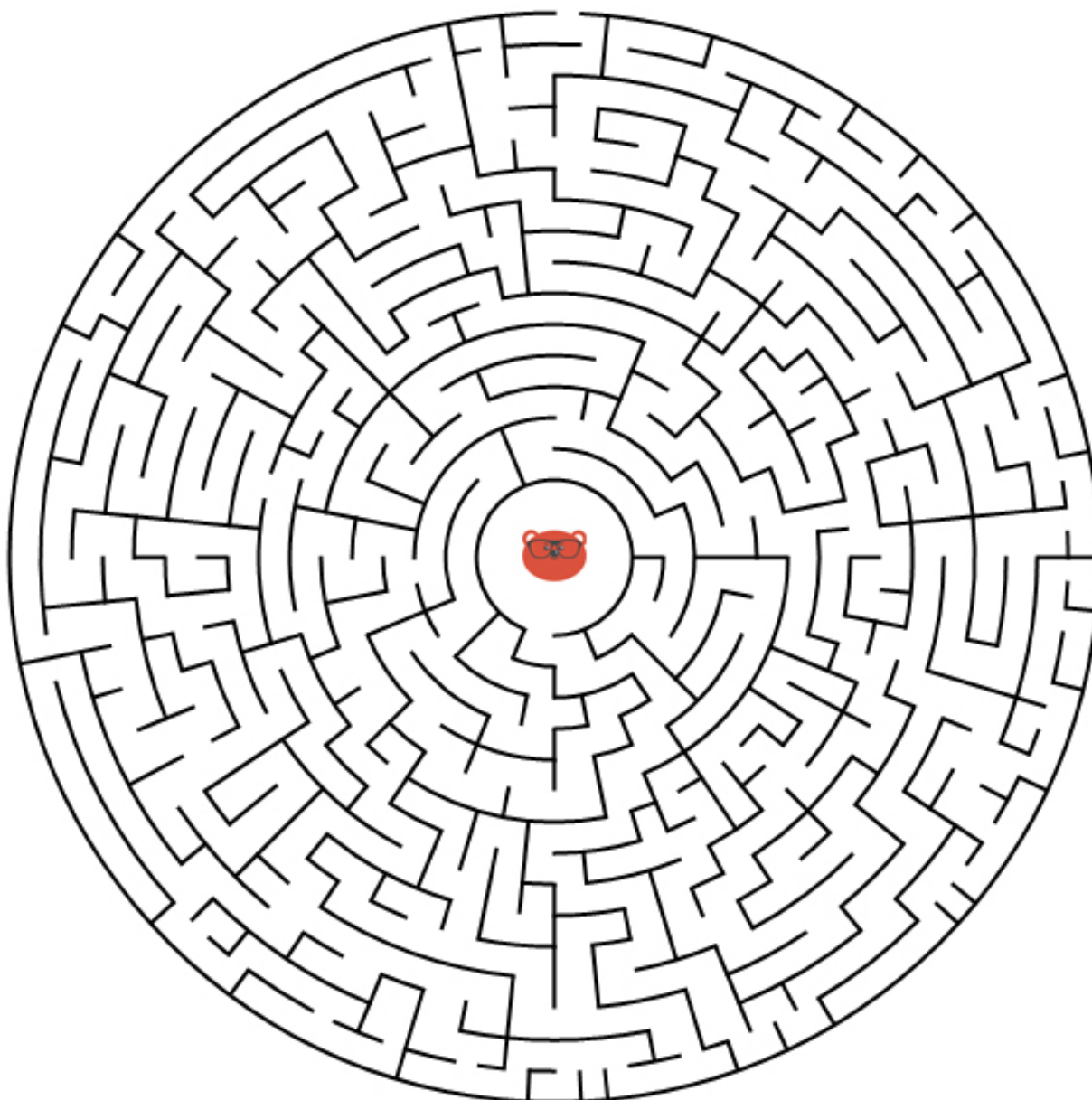

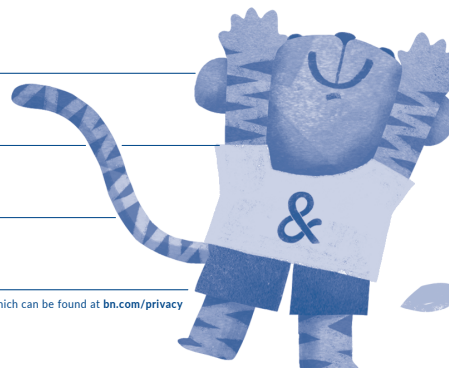

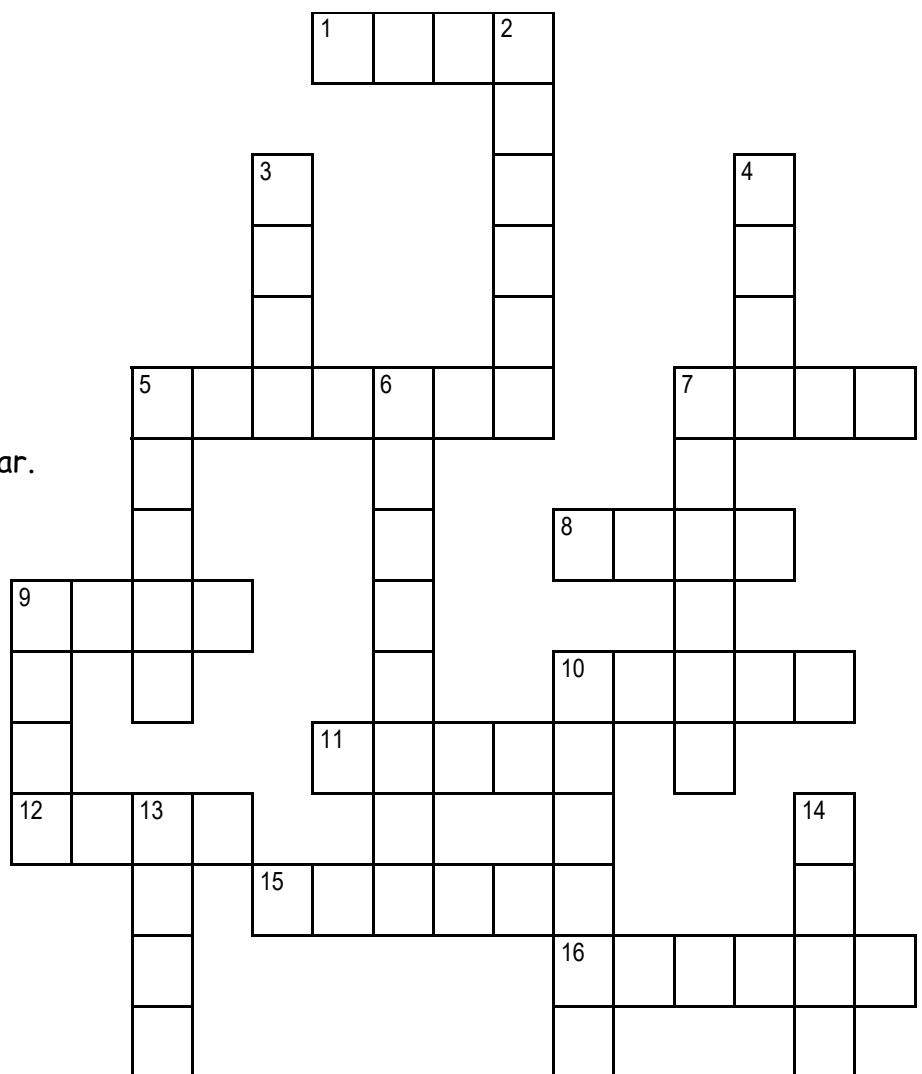
