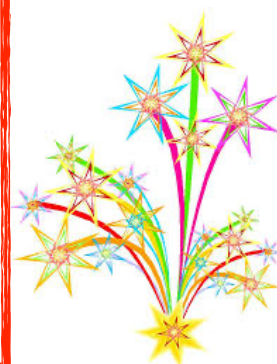
AMANDA COLPO's Winning PIE RECIPE

Ingredients:

- 1-Graham Cracker Crust
- 1-8oz Block of Cream Cheese
- 1-16 oz tub of Cool Whip
- 1-container of strawberries
- 1-tub of strawberry glaze
- 2-tablespoons of sugar
- 2-tablespoons of milk
- 1-tablespoon of vanilla extract

Directions:

1. Bake crust according to directions on package and let cool.
2. Cream together cream cheese and sugar with mixer. Works best with softened cream cheese.
3. Add milk and vanilla and mix some more.
4. Fold in Cool Whip to cream cheese mixture.
5. Put cream layer on top of graham cracker crust.
6. Wash and slice strawberries.
7. Add strawberry glaze to the strawberries.
8. Put strawberry layer on top of cream layer.
9. Cover with clear lid from crust and refrigerator and chill for an hour.
