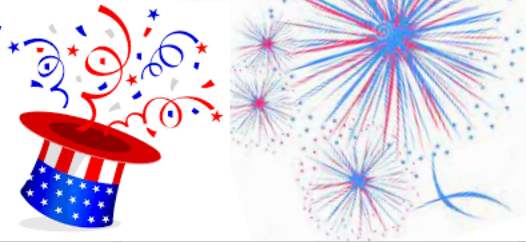
Things to bring to the meet:

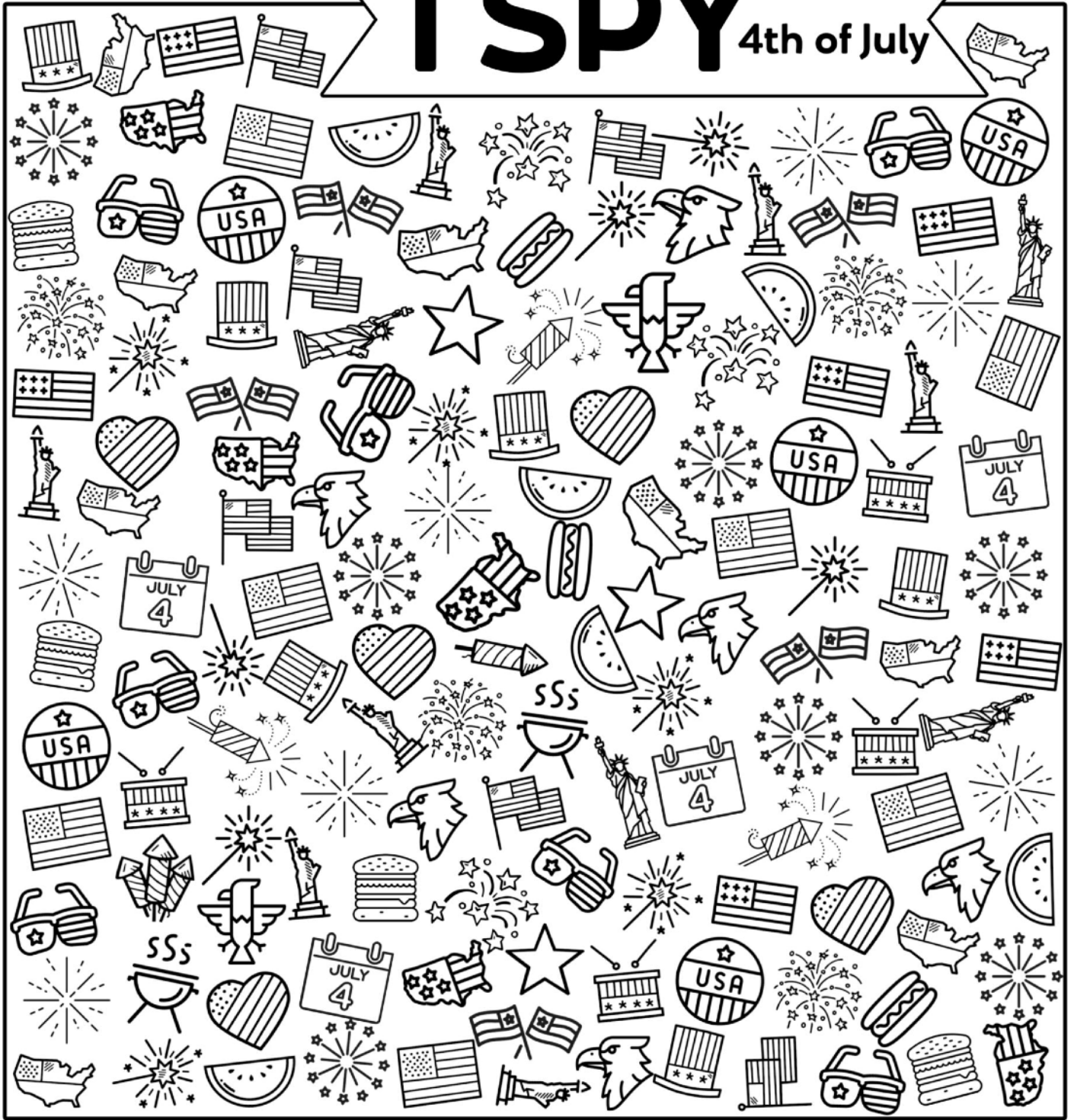
