When school bus stops for passengers, all traffic from both directions must stop.



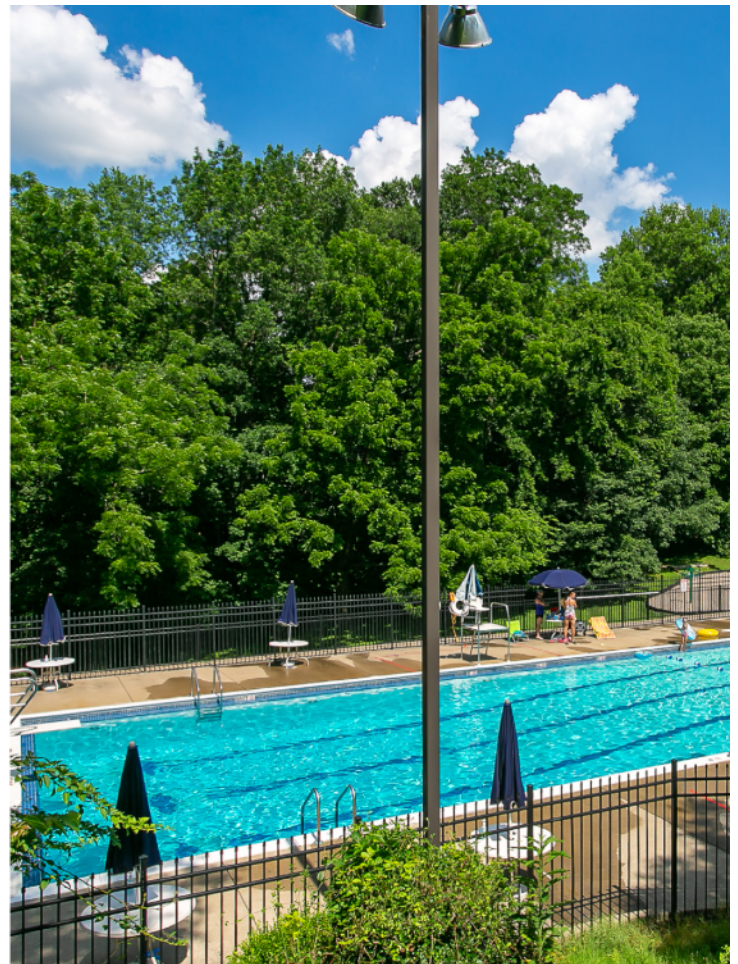
↑ 2 LANE ROADWAY + CENTER TURN

This is a reminder that when the school bus stop arm is out, **ALL TRAFFIC MUST STOP!**

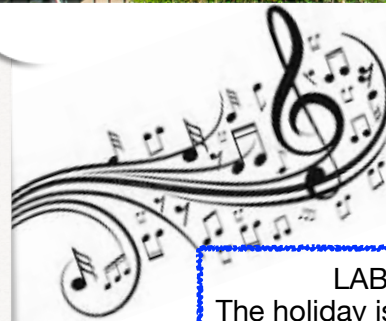
