#### **COMMISSIONERS CORNER**

Welcome to Commissioner's Corner...new to the gazette this year...where one of your commissioners will highlight the work they are doing for the city.

This Commission body has unanimously approved the initial steps towards addressing resident concern for traffic safety related to excessive speed within our city's border. The commission has heard various proposals and in consultation will be implementing radar based, driver speed notification signs that not only data log the vehicle volume and speeds but also flash to notify the oncoming vehicle is traveling too fast. The data logging recorded from these solar powered signs will be used to measure the traffic patterns and changes related to school opening and closing times and assist in determining the best hours for law enforcement to address inappropriate driver behavior.

These signs will be strategically placed and rotated around city owned rights-of-way. A Google form has been prepared for residents to communicate where they feel the signs should be placed. Residents may provide their input throughout February. In the coming weeks the Commission body will communicate with select, and interested residents where the signs will be implemented later this spring.




# PREPARE TO BE EXTRA BUGGED BY CICADAS IN 2024

In late April and early May 2024, when two different broods will emerge. The 17-year Brood XIII will emerge in Northern Illinois, while the 13-year Brood XIX will emerge in parts of Southeastern United States. It is not common to have a dual emergence between Broods XIII and XIX. They occur once every 221 years and the last time these two broods emerged together was in 1803. Thomas Jefferson was President of the United States. and Lewis and Clark started their exploration of s the Louisiana Purchase. We (the Science Community) ask your help in mapping the emergence of these early stragglers. Simply download the free Cicada Safari app from the Apple app store or Google play, then go on a safari to find periodical cicadas. Photograph and submit the periodical cicadas to Cicada Safari, and after the photos are verified, they will be posted to the live map. Cicada Safari was created by Dr. Gene Kritsky working with the Center for IT Engagement at Mount St. Joseph University in Cincinnati.

Cicadas are not dangerous and can provide some environmental benefits including: Cicadas are a valuable food source for birds and other predators. Cicadas can aerate lawns and improve water filtration into the ground. Cicadas add nutrients to the soil as they decompose.

What happens if a Cicada bites you? Technically, cicadas don't bite or sting; they do however pierce and suck. They might try to do this to you, but don't worry, they're just thinking you are a tree! Just remove the cicada from your person and go about your business!
