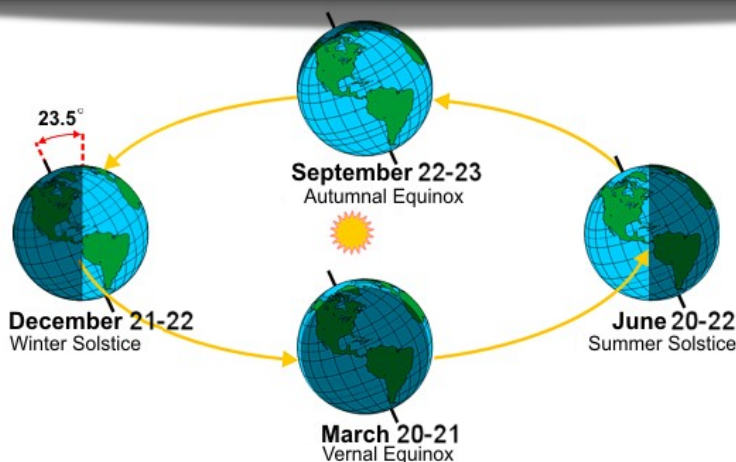
### A Message From Our Mayor:

Just a few thoughts with Spring approaching. As the weather gets warmer, more kids will be playing outside. Please be aware of this as you approach stop signs. Kids on bicycles do not tend to stop at stop signs like cars do. Please don't make assumptions when it comes to safety. Also, parking on the grass in front of your house is a violation of city ordinances. It also creates blind spots for your neighbors when they exit their driveways. Overflow parking when you have visitors must be on only one side of the road so as not to obstruct emergency vehicles.

The city is looking for four adult volunteers to be certified as lifeguards. They would only be called upon in cases where a lifeguard doesn't show up and there is a delay in getting a replacement.

Also, if you have a child over the age of fifteen, our pool is a great opportunity for summer work. The company supplying our lifeguards will offer certification classes in May.

4) Once you are a member and begin to fill out your info you can choose what will be shown online in the directory. (Kids names, pets, etc.)

5) Once you have completed your information you can then download the app if you would like for easier viewing of the directory. It's called Membership Toolkit and just easy to use as Facebook!

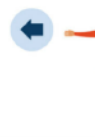

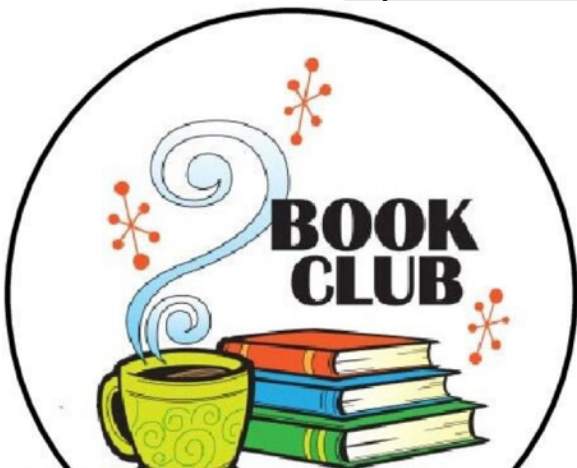

Hi! Your commissioner, Katie Danner here...I head up all things communication, social events, swim team, our Facebook page, website and a few other odds and ends.

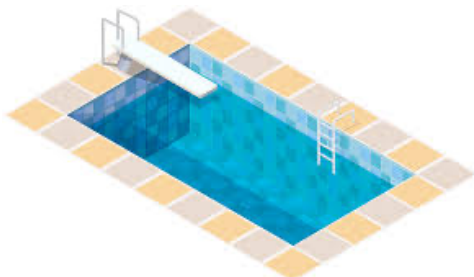
