Dear Resident:

The City of Brownsboro Farm along with Flynn Brother Paving is scheduled to begin road resurfacing along **Old Gate, Burning Bush**, and **Broadland** in the coming week.

The project will start with road milling on Thursday, August 1st, weather permitting(*). Do not park along the above roads between 6AM-8PM on Thursday, August 1st or you will risk being towed at your own expense.

The milling process will not impact trash collection, however, please do not place your waste receptacles in the roadways. All millings should be completed in a single day*. You may resume use of the bumpy roadway after milling crews and equipment have departed.

The re-paving portion of the work is scheduled*, on Saturday August 3rd or Monday, August 5th. A text Alert will be sent the day prior as a reminder to not park along the above roadways between 6AM-8PM or you risk being towed at your own expense.

The repaving is scheduled to be completed in a single day. The day following paving completion, crews will be back out to apply roadway letter stencils and striping.

Cash Flow

Shown below is the projected cash flow statement for the City of Brownsboro Farm for 2024-2025. Though our budget shows a surplus of cash for the fiscal year, we will actually reduce our cash balance substantially. If you look at the section, Cash from Asset Expenditures, you will see the capitol projects for the coming year. The two biggest assets in the city are the roads and the pool. Both assets are in dire need of improvements. Fortunately, the city has approximately \$120,000 of ARPA grant funds which we are required to spend by the end of the year.

We will spend around \$110,000 on paving and sealing projects. It has been a few years since we have done any paving, so this will put us back on schedule with the master plan.

The pool is eighteen years old and is in need of refurbishing. We started the project this past spring and hope to have it completed by the start of the 2025 pool season.
