More Road Work...

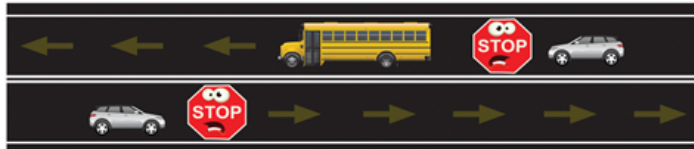

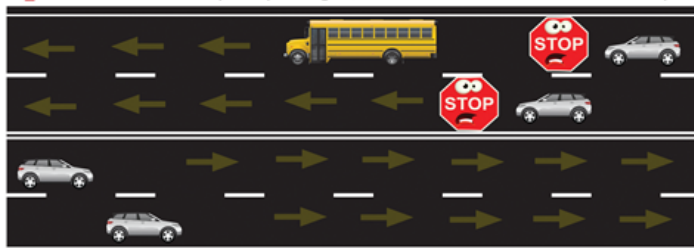

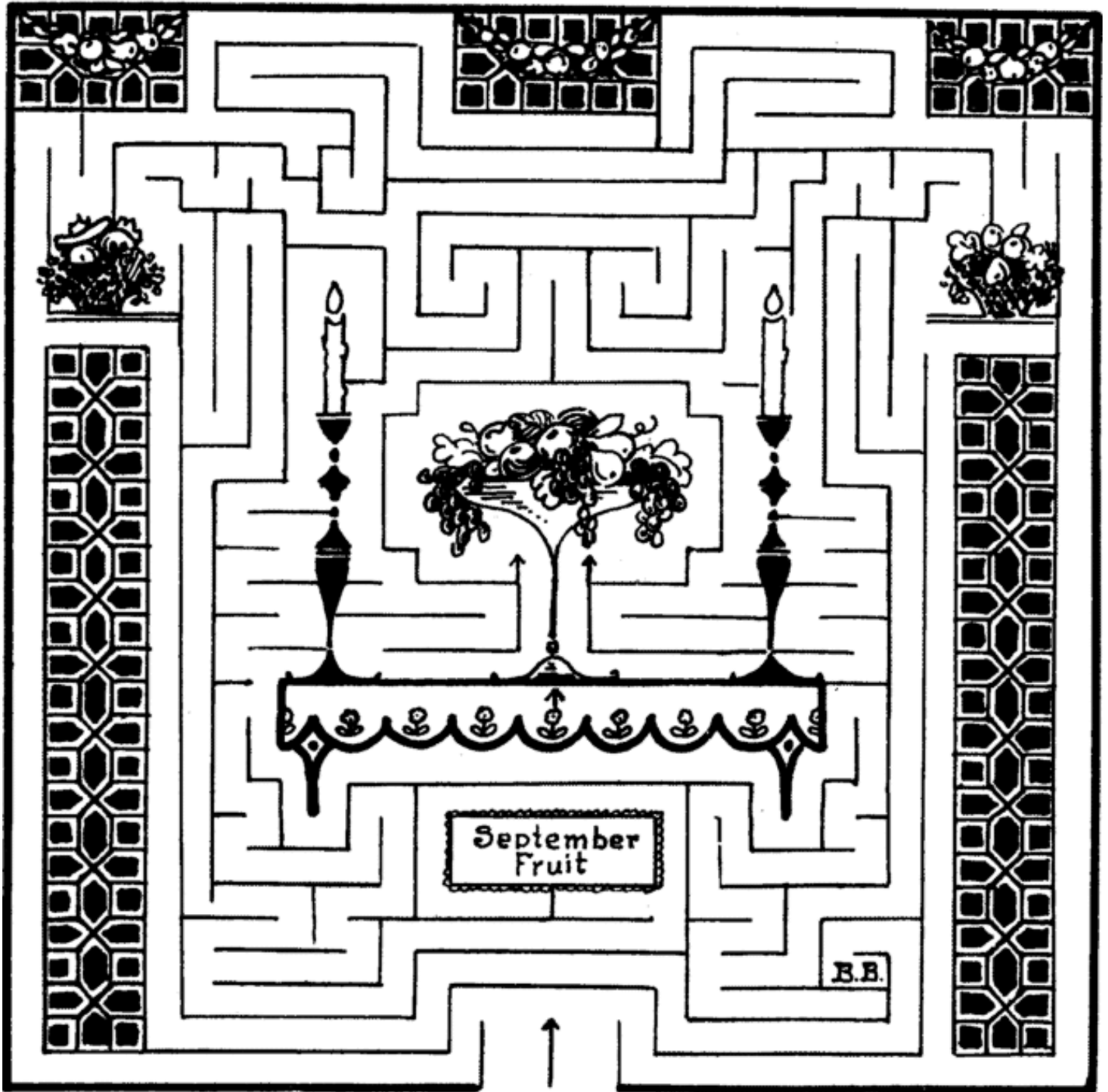
