1) Go to this link:

2) click Register/Login and then either create an account (or log in with a Membership Toolkit account if you have one with another organization - like a school).

3) You will be asked to verify your email and then log back in with your password and add your homeowner information which will build our directory and database.

Please note that when you create your account and receive the email to verify, that link expires within 2 hours.

4) Once you are a member and begin to fill out your info you can choose what will be shown online in the directory. (Kids names, pets, etc.)

5) Once you have completed your information you can then download the app if you would like for easier viewing of the directory. It's called Membership Toolkit and just easy to use as Facebook!

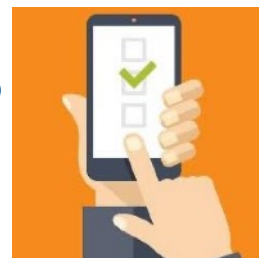

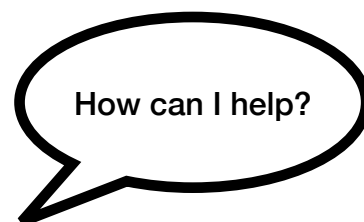
BROWNSBORO FARM 2025 SOCIAL EVENTS
