
Jimmy Stout

Have received an explanation from KLC regarding the ordinance to put a board in place as well as code violations.

A quote from We Rescue You Staffing has been received in the amount of \$43,000. Mayor Jimmy Stout would like to negotiate free lifeguard training in exchange for using our facilities. Need to get three volunteers for emergency lifeguards.

Motion to approve a back up motor for the pool in the amount of \$1,200 by Commissioner Brian Augustine, 2nd by Commissioner Katie Danner. Passed unanimously.
