- Children 11 and under are not allowed at the pool with only an older sibling. They must be accompanied by an adult (parent/ guardian or babysitter).
- Please sign in when entering the pool area.
- Keep the pool gate closed at all times for everyone's safety.
- When the lifeguards call "break," that means everyone must exit the pool—time for a rest and a snack!
- Clean up after yourselves before you leave—let's all pitch in to keep our pool in tip-top shape all summer long.
- Guests of the pool are required to wear their quest bands at all times.
- Absolutely NO Glass Containers inside the pool area.

We're also excited to cheer on our very own **Brownsboro Farm Swim Team—the Marlins!** This year, the Marlins will be hosting **two home swim meets** on **June 2nd** and **June 30th**. Please note that on these dates, the pool will **close at 4:00 PM** to allow time for meet setup. We encourage everyone to come out and support the team—it's a fun way to build community and show off that Farm spirit! **Our concession stand will be open during the meets**, so bring your appetite and enjoy some tasty snacks while you cheer on the Marlins!

- 4) Once you are a member and begin to fill out your info you can choose what will be shown online in the directory. (Kids names, pets, etc.)
- 5) Once you have completed your information you can then download the app if you would like for easier viewing of the directory. It's called Membership Toolkit and just easy to use as Facebook!



We'll be working on a plan to make these improvements soon.


Honoring a Legacy:



2025 Private Pool Party Agreement - Members only **POOL RENTAL AGREEMENT**

The pool member(s) and family (hereinafter "I/we") are responsible for the conduct of our guests and the contents of the pool area. I / we also agree to be responsible for the cleanliness of the pool and surrounding area during the hours we have rented the pool. I / we agree to pay for any damages and/or clean-up expenses incurred.

I/we agree to abide by all City of Brownsboro Farm pool regulations as outlined in the pool member's packet.

Alcoholic beverages **are not** to be served at a party for minors. (Persons under the age of 21). If alcoholic beverages are found on the premises at a party for minors, the party will end and the pool will be closed. A refund will not be given for a party terminated for alcoholic beverages being served to minors. **No glass** containers are allowed inside the fenced area.

The **responsible adult member** must be present on the pool premises for the entire duration of the party. You must clean up all areas used including: Playground, patio & parking lot. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of the damage deposit.

There is a rental fee of \$200 for a party of up to 50 people and \$275 for parties over 50 people, as well as a \$200 damage deposit. \$50 of the rental fee will be needed to be put down at time of booking to ensure we can confirm a lifeguard. The remainder of the fees shall be paid to the pool monitor at least one week prior to the date of the party (these fees do not include access to the Community Center) in addition, there is a fee of \$20 per hour/per lifeguard, will be supplied by We Rescue You Staffing.

Parties may normally be scheduled any day between closing to 12:00 am. Parties at other times require permission from the Pool Monitor.


