Regular Commission Meeting  
Tuesday, January 13, 2026**

A regular meeting of the City of Brownsboro Farm Commission was held on Tuesday, 1/13/26. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. Present were Mayor Jimmy Stout, Commissioner Katie Danner, Commissioner Amanda Colpo, Commissioner Doug Walker, Commissioner Brian Augustine and City Clerk/Treasurer Jennifer McIntyre.

The January agenda was adopted. Motion by Commissioner Amanda Colpo, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Katie Danner. Passed unanimously.

The minutes from December were approved. Motion by Commissioner Brian Augustine, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Katie Danner. Passed unanimously.

Financials for December 2025 were also approved. Motion by Commissioner Doug Walker, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Brian Augustine. Passed unanimously.

Due to fraudulent activity during December 2025-January 2026 in the General Checking Account and Parks Checking Account there will need to be two new accounts set up.

Motion to approve Katie Danner reimbursement for the light up the farm gift cards in the amount of \$100 by Commissioner Amanda Colpo, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Doug Walker. Passed unanimously.

Motion to approve Jennifer McIntyre reimbursement for a mailbox lock and payroll fees in the amount of \$42.66 by Commissioner Katie Danner, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Amanda Colpo. Passed unanimously.

**Parks Board**

**Code Enforcement Board Ordinance**

There have been 2 people interested in the code enforcement board which were one internally and one in Meadowvale. Will correct ordinances that were suggested by Meadowvale which were a fine on trash and towing that will invalidate the previous ordinance and the first reading will be done in February with the second reading to be done in March. Will need to post the ordinance in the newspaper and online.

**Code of Ethics Board**

Need a board with a minimum of three people. Can be a City Commissioner and if something is brought to the board then elect two more. Motion to have Commissioner Doug Walker act as Commissioner Representative for the Code of Ethics Board by Commissioner Brian Augustine, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Amanda Colpo. Passed unanimously.

Motion to approve up to \$275 for the dinner club kick-off party by Commissioner Katie Danner, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Amanda Colpo. Passed unanimously.

Motion to approve Searce Landscaping's contract from 3/1/26-2/28/27 in the amount of \$33,900 which is 3% year over year by Commissioner Brian Augustine, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Katie Danner. Passed unanimously.

Drainage culvert needs to be cleaned out by Chip Swanson's house to 2<sup>nd</sup> bridge by community center. Motion to approve up to \$700 from parks and \$100 from roads for removal of leaves from ditches by Searce Landscaping by Commissioner Brian Augustine, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Katie Danner. Passed unanimously.

**Doug Walker**


Nothing to report.
