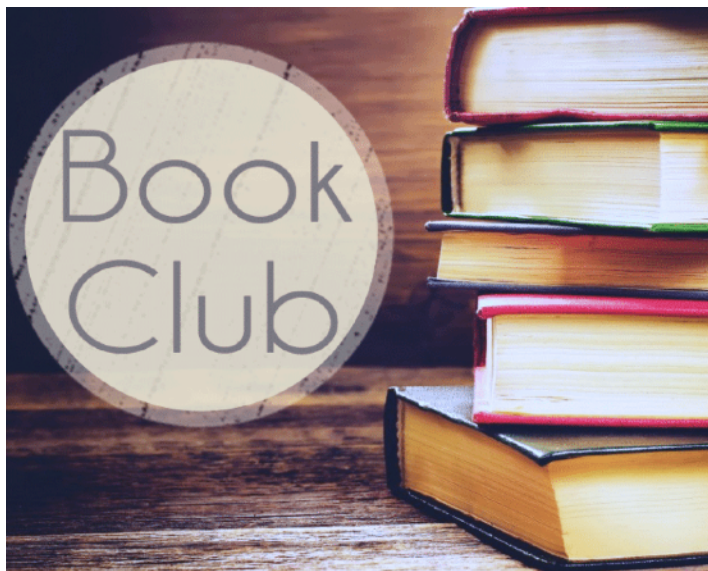

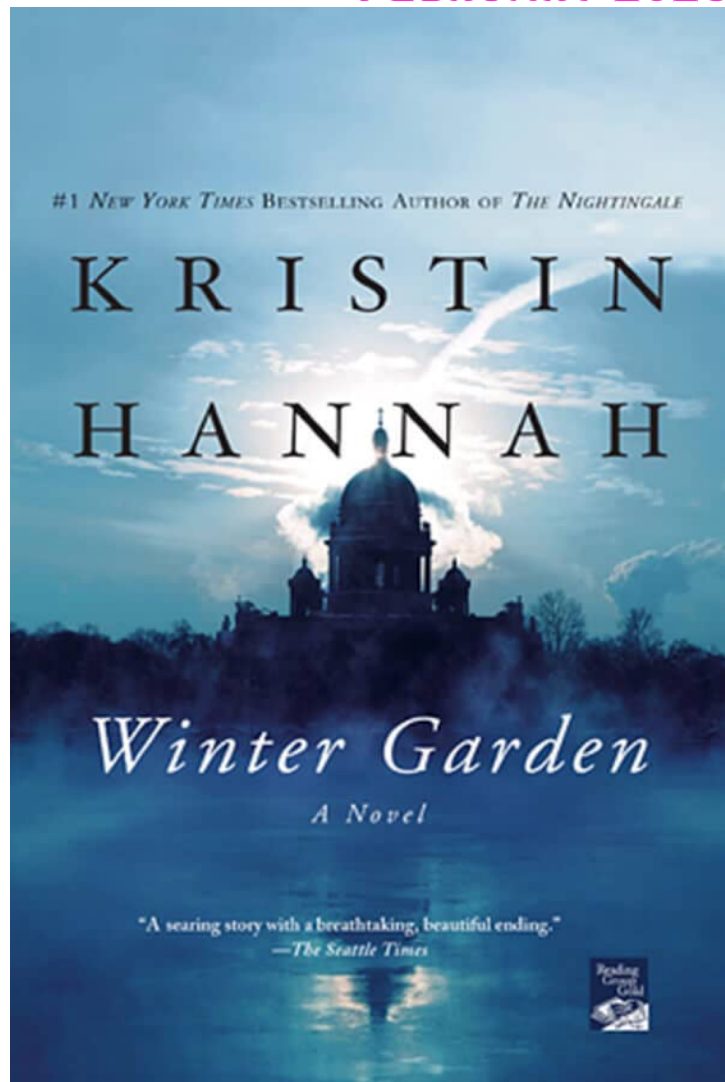

____ I bravely fought to abolish slavery. I used my words and voice to fight for the rights of my fellow African Americans.

C. Martin Luther King Jr.

____ We were a group of African-American military pilots who bravely fought in World War II.

D. Harriet Tubman

____ I was the first African American woman to be issued a pilot's license. I went on to encourage many others to do the same.

E. George Washington Carver

____ I was an African American research chemist and a pioneer in the field of medicine.

F. Tuskegee Airmen

____ My given name is Isabella Baumfree and I was an African-American abolitionist and women's rights activist who escaped slavery in 1826.

G. Rosa Parks

____ I was a Baptist minister and civil-rights activist most known for the advancement of civil rights using nonviolent civil disobedience.

H. Bessie Coleman

____ I was an African-American abolitionist and humanitarian. After I escaped slavery myself, I returned to help other slaves escape the same fate using the Underground Railroad.

I. Thurgood Marshall

____ I was an American botanist and inventor best known for my groundbreaking work with peanuts and sweet potatoes.

____ I refused to give up my seat on the bus. I am often referred to as "the first lady of civil rights."
