## Commissioner's Corner

Dear Brownsboro Farm Neighbors,

We are already preparing for another wonderful summer at the pool! The **2026 Pool Packet is now available online and at the clubhouse**, and we encourage all residents to review it as you plan for the season. We are happy to share that **membership fees will not be increasing this year**, as we remain committed to keeping our pool affordable and accessible for our neighborhood families.

Please mark your calendars for our annual **Pool & Park Clean-Up Day on Saturday, April 18th at 9:30 AM** (rain date: April 25th). Residents who participate in the clean-up will receive a \$25 discount on their pool membership. It's a great way to serve our community and help us get the pool ready for opening day.

As we begin the new season, there are two important rule updates to be aware of. All guests must wear ID bands at all times, and guests entering without a pool member may be banned for the remainder of the season. In addition, responsible, approved supervision must check in with the lifeguard on duty and identify the children they are supervising. While children age 11 may enter independently, they are not considered responsible supervision for younger children. Teen supervisors or babysitters must be at least 14 years old.

Be on the lookout for information about joining our **Marlins Swim Team** — membership registration will be opening soon! As a friendly reminder, we will host two home meets this year, and on those days the pool will close at 4:00 PM to accommodate the events.

We look forward to another safe, fun, and sunny summer at the Brownsboro Farm Pool.

- 5) Once you have completed your information you can then download the app if you would like for easier viewing of the directory. It's called Membership Toolkit and just easy to use as Facebook!

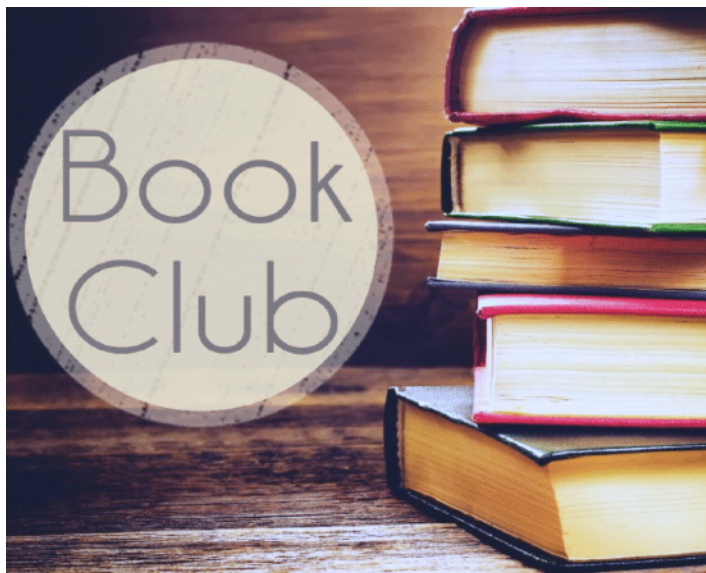

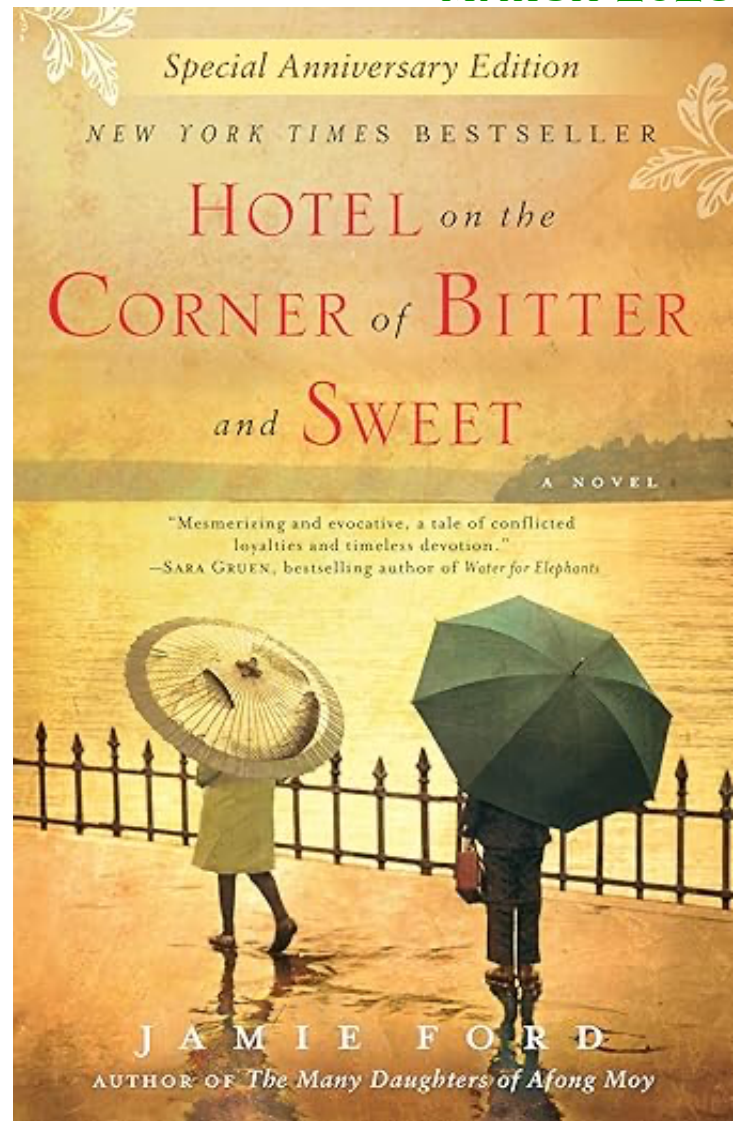

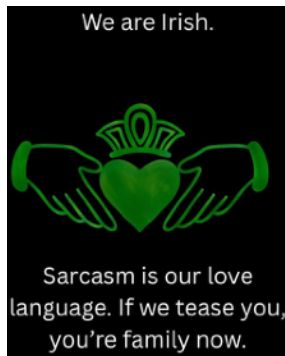

**The City of Brownsboro Farm Pool Regulations**

The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all members and to assure the safe and sanitary operation of the pool. Parents are required to instruct their children to observe the rules and to obey the instructions of the lifeguards and Pool Monitor.

Any failure to comply with these rules / instructions shall be considered sufficient cause for immediate suspension of pool privileges for the offender.

All persons using any of the pool and park facilities do so at their own risk. The City will not be responsible for any accident or injury in connection with the use.

The City will not be responsible for any loss or damage to personal items.

**The Pool may be closed or the operating hours revised, for maintenance, weather, or any other reasons deemed sufficient.**

Health and Safety: The following requirements are from the Louisville and Jefferson County Board of Health Regulations, Chapter 900, Swimming Pools and Bathing Beaches. 900.1702 Facilities shall enforce the following rules. These rules shall be posted on placards at the entrance to the pool area. Lettering on this placard shall be at least 1/2 inches in height.

- A. Admission to the facility shall be refused to all persons having any contagious disease, or those with conditions that appear contagious. Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions which have not healed, corn plasters, bunion pads, adhesive tape, rubber bandages of any kind are not permitted. A person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted in the facility area.
- B. No glass or gum within the pool area *NO SMOKING OR VAPING INSIDE THE FENCED AND PATIO AREA*
- C. No food, drink, tobacco or vaping products allowed outside designated areas (including the pool edge and within the pool itself – no exceptions) *CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF & YOUR CHILDREN*
- D. No running or rough play allowed.
- E. No street shoes allowed on deck.
- F. All apparel worn into the facility shall be clean.
- G. All persons must shower before entering the pool.
- H. No diving in shallow water.
- I. No animals allowed in the area.

**In addition to the above listed rules, the City of Brownsboro Farm adds the following:**

- Neighborhood residents may not be guests of the pool.
- Guests are only allowed to visit the pool two weekdays and one weekend day for a total of 3 days per week. 2 Guests maximum on Holiday Weekends (Memorial Day, 4th of July and Labor Day)

- If a resident's city taxes are not current and delinquent, they may not join the pool until payment has been received.
- Non-Residents that are members of the 2026 Marlins Swim Team are eligible to become members of the pool in 2026. Additional charges may apply.
- All water guns, water pistols, soakers, etc are strictly prohibited from the pool area.
- There will be no running, pushing, wrestling, dunking, or excessive roughness in or about the pool area or bathhouse.
- All persons entering the pool area must be appropriately dressed for swimming. No one dressed in shorts, slacks or other street apparel will be permitted in the pool.
- Large floatation devices may only be used at the guards discretion.
- No more than one person will be allowed on the diving board at a time. Divers are permitted to dive from the front end of the board only when the diving area is clear of swimmers. Divers are not to jump to the pool's sides. Divers must exit from the sides of the pool. Diving with or on to floatation devices is not permitted.
- Absolutely NO disposable diapers will be permitted in either pool. Disposable swim diapers are allowed. Please be considerate to other swimmers.
- Guests must wear ID Bands at all times.
  - Guests entering without a pool member may be banned for the remainder of the pool season.

**Member Obligations:**

- No child under the age of 11 shall be left without parental or approved supervision.
- Responsible, approved supervision MUST check in with the lifeguard on duty & identify for which children they have responsibility.
- Ex. Responsible, approved supervision MUST check in with the lifeguard on duty and identify which children they are responsible for. Children age 11 are permitted to enter the pool independently but are NOT considered responsible supervision for younger children. Teen supervisors or babysitters must be at least 14 years of age.
- Lifeguards may implement a swim test at their discretion.
- Sign the Pool Register when entering the pool area - indicate the number of Members & Guests.
- Observe Pool Hours and Restrictions.
- No offensive or abusive language will be permitted.
- Food or drink containers, of any kind, are not permitted in the pool itself.
- No loud or offensive music will be allowed.
- All bicycles, roller blades and skateboards will be left outside the fenced area. • *Please utilize the bike rack!*
- Property damage will be charged to the responsible member.
- Only "We Rescue You Staffing" lifeguards can provide swim lessons at the pool.

**NOTE: The lifeguards and pool monitor have the right and authority to ask adult members to refrain from further consumption of alcohol and/or to remove themselves from the premises. No person under the age of 21 shall consume alcohol at the pool.**

**LIFEGUARD BREAKS:**

- From 10 minutes before the hour until the hour, the lifeguard is not on duty and NO ONE will be permitted in the pool. (Health Department rule)
- Adults may swim during break only on days when two lifeguards are on duty and one remains on the deck supervising the pool. Reminder: the break allows guards time to cool off, use the restroom, and refocus.

**POOL FURNITURE:**

- Tables, chairs and chaise lounges are intended for use by members and their guests only while present in the pool area, therefore pool furniture cannot be reserved for later use by placing towels or personal belongings on the tables or chairs.
- Pool furniture should only be moved temporarily and should be placed back in its proper place when leaving the pool area.

**Anti-Bullying Policy:**

Bullying of any kind including use of offensive language is unacceptable and will not be tolerated. We are committed to providing a safe and friendly environment for all of our members. If bullying does occur, the incident will be dealt with promptly and will be considered to be a serious violation of Pool Regulations, disciplinary action to include possible suspension or revocation to membership. Anyone who knows that bullying is happening is expected to report the incident to a lifeguard, pool monitor, commissioner or parks board member.

**Penalties For Violations of Pool Rules and Regulations:**

The consequences for violation of the pool rules are as follows:

- 1st Infraction: sent home for the day
- 2nd Infraction: Suspension for 7 days
- 3rd Infraction: Suspension for the rest of the pool season as deemed by lifeguards, Pool Monitor, or Member of the Commission.
- Members who trespass on pool property after hours will be suspended for the duration of the pool season. They may be prosecuted for trespassing.
- Members responsible for any acts of vandalism will be expected to pay for the repairs. Any acts of vandalism or injury to others will also lead to a suspension for a period determined by the Pool Monitor.

**2026 Private Pool Party Agreement – City Members Only**

The pool member(s) and family (herein referred to as I/We) are responsible for the conduct of our guests and the contents of the pool area. I/we also agree to be responsible for the cleanliness of the pool and surrounding areas during the hours we have rented the pool.

I/we agree to pay for any damages and/or clean-up expenses incurred. I/we agree to abide by all City of Brownsboro Farm pool regulations as outlined in the pool member’s packet.

Alcoholic beverages **are not** to be served at a party for minors. (Persons under the age of 21) If alcoholic beverages are found on the premises at a party for minors, the party will end and the pool will be closed. A refund will not be given for a party terminated for alcoholic beverages being served to minors. **No glass** containers are allowed inside the fenced area.

The **responsible adult member** must be present on the pool premises for the entire duration of the party. You must clean up all areas used including: playground, patio, & parking lot. Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of the damage deposit.

There is a rental fee of \$200 for a party of up to 50 people and \$275 for parties over 50 people, as well as a \$200 damage deposit. \$50 of the rental fee will be needed to be put down at a time of booking to ensure we can confirm a lifeguard. The remainder of fees shall be paid to the Pool Monitor at least one week prior to the date of the party (these fees do not include access to the Community Center). In addition, there is a fee of \$20 per hour/per lifeguard (guards provided by We Rescue You Staffing).

**POOL MEMBER IS REQUIRED TO PAY GUARDS BY THE CONCLUSION OF YOUR PARTY**

Parties may normally be scheduled any day between closing for up to three hours after closing. Parties at other times require permissions from the Pool Monitor.

**Pool Member’s Release**

The pool member signing this release, on behalf of themselves and their family members, shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Brownsboro Farm, its Commission, agents and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses (including attorney’s fees), arising from their and/or their guest’s use of the pool and adjoining facilities.

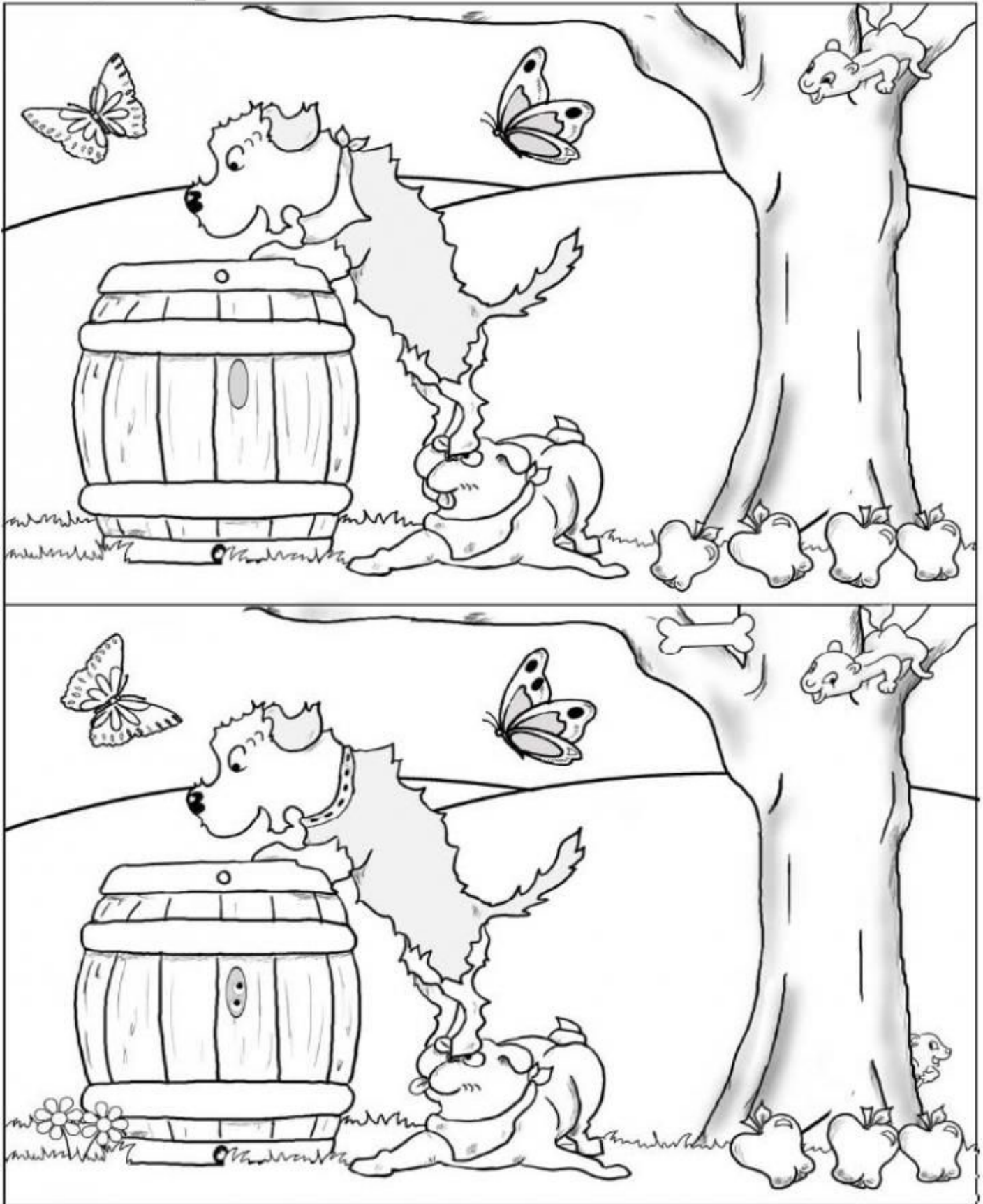

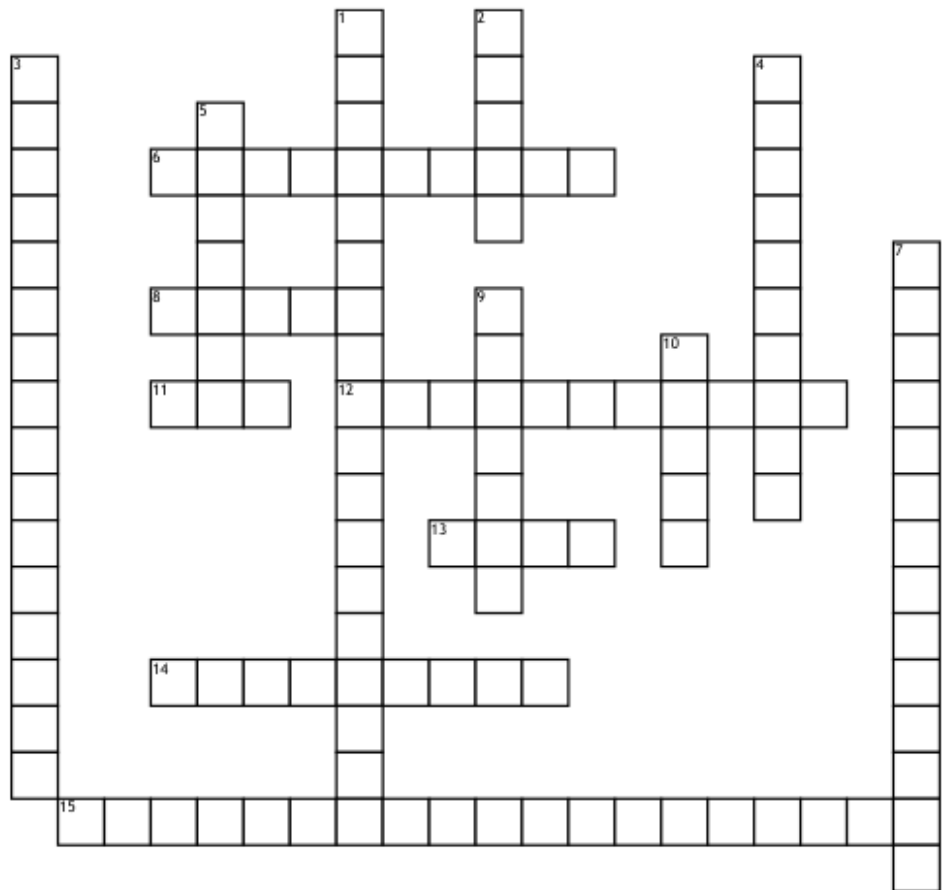
