

**City of Brownsboro Farm
Regular Commission Meeting
Tuesday June 9, 2026**

A regular meeting of the City of Brownsboro Farm Commission was held on Tuesday, 6/9/26. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. Present were Mayor Jimmy Stout, Commissioner Katie Danner, Commissioner Amanda Colpo, Commissioner Doug Walker, Commissioner Brian Augustine, City Clerk/Treasurer Jennifer McIntyre, Brian Durbin & Karen Balogh.

The June agenda was adopted. Motion by Commissioner Katie Danner, 2nd by Commissioner Doug Walker. Passed unanimously.

The minutes from May were approved. Motion by Commissioner Brian Augustine, 2nd by Commissioner Katie Danner. Passed unanimously.

Financials for May 2026 were also approved. Motion by Commissioner Katie Danner, 2nd by Commissioner Amanda Colpo. Passed unanimously.

Motion not to exceed \$500 for the men's bathroom lock by Commissioner Katie Danner, 2nd by Commissioner Amanda Colpo. Passed unanimously.

Motion to approve reimbursement to Brian Durbin in the amount of \$247.69 by Mayor Jimmy Stout, 2nd by Commissioner Amanda Colpo. Passed unanimously.

Motion to approve reimbursement to Jennifer McIntyre in the amount of \$550 for KLC dues by Mayor Jimmy Stout, 2nd by Commissioner Amanda Colpo. Passed unanimously.

Parks Board

Motion to approve the parks ruling of removing standing trees (dead or alive) in Brownsboro Farm Bar on the City of Brownsboro Farm property without the permission from the Parks Board or city commission is prohibited by Commissioner Amanda Colpo, 2nd by Commissioner Katie Danner. Passed unanimously.

The following budget wants were discussed and prioritized from the parks board.

1. Coffee Tables – a long and 2 round tables
2. Straps for Chairs at Pool
3. Copula
4. Community Center Floor Maintenance

Code Enforcement Board Enforcement

To meet quarterly on the 3rd Tuesday of the month.

The board will consist of Eli Mike to serve a 2 year term, Steve Zabloudil to serve a 3 year term and Brad Chumbley to serve a 1 year term. The alternate will be Wendy Medley to serve a 1 year term. 2. Pool Motor \$2,500

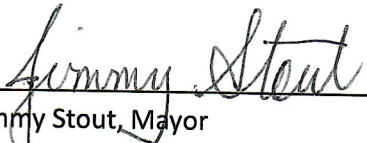
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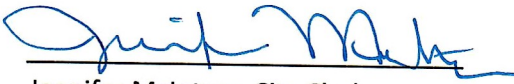
3. Chlorine Tank Move \$5,500

First reading of the city and park tax was held. Reading of City Ordinance 1, Series 2027 for real property fiscal tax rate of \$.1562 per \$100 with a 2% discount for early payment, 10-20% for late payment plus 12% interest accrued annum

Reading of City Ordinance 2, Series 2027 for park fiscal tax rate of \$.05 per \$100 with a 2% discount for early payment, 10-20% for late payment plus 12% interest accrued annum.
