Commissioner Amanda Colpo is also working to get another quote on possibly installing fans into the pump room instead of moving the chlorine tank.

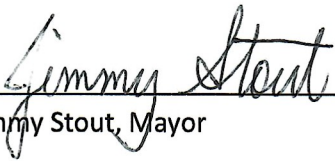
Doug Walker
